PAINT/CHEMICAL/HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY WILL CLOSE FOR 2014 SEASON ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 30TH

The Oneida-Herkimer Household Hazardous Waste Facility will close for the 2014 season on Tuesday, September 30th.

Residents of Oneida and Herkimer Counties may continue to deliver oil-based and latex paints, herbicides, pesticides, cleaners, chemicals and other household hazardous waste through the month of September to the Household Hazardous Waste Facility, located at the end of Leland Ave., Utica as per the following schedule:

MONDAY – FRIDAY: 8:00 AM TO 4:00 PM SATURDAY: 7:00 AM TO 2:00 PM

Electronics/televisions/computer equipment, propane cylinders (under 100 lbs.), fluorescent light bulbs and many other common household items are accepted year-round.
