Solid Waste Authority Provides Electronics Recycling Options for Oneida and Herkimer County Residents

Beginning January 1, 2015, the New York State Electronic Equipment Recycling and Reuse Act will prohibit all households and generators of electronic waste from disposing of electronic waste such as computers, computer components, televisions and other electronic devices as garbage.

Since 2003, Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority (the Authority) has offered a drop-off program for electronics recycling to residents and businesses in the two-County region and recycled over 800,000 pounds of electronic waste in 2014.

Electronic waste CANNOT be placed in your curbside recycling container.

OPTIONS FOR RECYCLING UNWANTED ELECTRONICS:

- Residents should contact their municipality or waste hauler for electronic waste collection
- Donate or sell unwanted, working electronics.
- Residents may deliver unwanted electronic waste to the Authority's Utica and Rome Convenience Station year- round, at no charge for proper recycling.
