Solid Waste Authority Offers Cleanup Tips for Fall

As the summer season comes to an end, many of us begin cleaning up our yards and homes in order to prepare for the cold weather months.

The Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority offers the following guidelines to assist with summer cleanups.

How Do I Dispose Of	
Inflatable Pool Floats	DO NOT PLACE IN RECYCLING BIN
	Inflatable pool floats should be placed in your regular garbage.
BULKY RIGID PLASTICS	DO NOT PLACE IN RECYCLING BIN
(Plastic lawn furniture, toys, coolers, garbage cans & more)	DELIVER TO: Authority's Utica or Rome Convenience Stations at no charge
	OR Contact your municipality for collection schedule.
Propane Tanks	DO NOT PLACE IN RECYCLING BIN
(1 lb. to 100 lb. tanks/cylinders)	DELIVER TO: Authority's Utica or Rome Convenience Stations at no charge.
Pool Chemicals/Paint/	DO NOT PLACE IN RECYCLING BIN
Household Hazardous Waste	DELIVER TO: Authority's Household Hazardous Waste Facility at no charge until <u>September 30th.</u>
	Empty containers and hardened paint cans should be placed in your regular garbage.
Garden Hoses	DO NOT PLACE IN RECYCLING BIN
	All garden hoses should be placed in regular garbage.
Green Waste	DO NOT PLACE IN RECYCLING BIN
(Leaves, Grass Clippings, Garden Waste)	DELIVER TO: Authority's Utica or Rome Convenience Stations OR Contact your municipality for collection schedule.
