# Solid Waste Authority Offers Cleanup Tips for End of Summer

As the summer season comes to an end, many of us begin cleaning up our yards and homes in order to prepare for the cold weather months.

The Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority offers the following guidelines to assist with fall cleanups.

How Do I Dispose Of	
Inflatable Pool Floats	DO NOT PLACE IN RECYCLING BIN
	Inflatable pool floats should be placed in your regular garbage.
Bulky Rigid Plastics	<u>DO NOT</u> PLACE IN RECYCLING BIN
(Plastic lawn furniture, toys,	DELIVER TO:
coolers, garbage cans & more)	Authority's EcoDrop Utica or EcoDrop Rome at no charge OR
	Contact your municipality for collection schedule.
Propane Tanks	<u>DO NOT</u> PLACE IN RECYCLING BIN
(1 lb. to 100 lb.	DELIVER TO:
tanks/cylinders)	Authority's EcoDrop Utica or EcoDrop Rome at no charge.
Pool Chemicals/Paint/	<u>DO NOT</u> PLACE IN RECYCLING BIN
Household Hazardous	DELIVER TO:
Waste	Authority's EcoDrop Utica at no charge until <u>September 30<sup>th</sup>.</u>
	Empty containers and hardened paint cans should be placed in your regular garbage.
Garden Hoses	DO NOT PLACE IN RECYCLING BIN
	All garden hoses should be placed in your regular garbage.
Green Waste	DO NOT PLACE IN RECYCLING BIN
(Leaves, Grass Clippings,	DELIVER TO:
Garden Waste)	Authority's EcoDrop Utica or EcoDrop Rome
	OR Contact your municipality for collection schedule.

 Saturday: 8:00 am – 12:00 pm

Keep in mind that pizza boxes, aluminum foil and plastic cups (i.e. Solo cups) are recyclable in your curbside container. Disposable utensils, plates and napkins are not recyclable and should be placed in your regular garbage.

The Authority encourages reuse before disposal. There are various locations and organizations in Oneida and Herkimer Counties that accept used items as a donation for reuse or recycling. Please visit <a href="www.ohswa.org">www.ohswa.org</a> for a list of organizations and acceptable items.

"As cleanups take place, questions arise about how to properly dispose of various items. The quality of recyclables is more important to the success of recycling than ever. If a resident is unsure whether something is recyclable, we ask that they dispose of the item as garbage until they find the answer," stated Authority Recycling Educator Jamie Tuttle.
