VILLAGE OF DOLGEVILLE

SOLID WASTE/TRASH/RECYCLING GUIDELINES - EFFECTIVE 1/01/2020

Residents have the option to use either Village of Dolgeville garbage bags or carts. The bag and cart system applies to all Village residents and businesses that do not have private dumpster service or a private collection dumpster contract. Please note: Residents who do not participate in the public solid waste collection system will not receive service for recycling.

Households that utilize the Village garbage bags or the cart system for garbage will also receive a cart for recyclables. Recyclables must be placed inside the cart loosely, with no plastic bags, string or twine. See reverse side for recycling guidelines.

VILLAGE GARBAGE BAGS

If you choose to use Village of Dolgeville blue garbage bags, they are available at:

<u>Cost for the Bags</u>: Large = \$3.75 Small = \$3.25

CART SYSTEM

Cost for Carts [Payments to be made quarterly, in advance]:

32-gallon = \$65.00 per quarter 64-gallon = \$82.50 per quarter 95-gallon = \$100.00 per quarter

LARGE QUANTITIES OF TRASH [This includes all construction and demolition material]

- Call a private hauler to rent a dumpster.
- Construction & demolition debris must be removed by the resident or by arrangement with a private hauler.
- > Small pieces of wood, lumber or construction debris can be placed in a cart or Village garbage bags (DO NOT mix with yard waste).

SCHEDULE/RULES FOR SETTING OUT GARBAGE AND RECYCLABLES

- Garbage and recyclables will be collected on <u>Thursday</u>.
- > Garbage should NOT be out before 3:00 PM on Tuesday but SHOULD be out before 12:00 Midnight on Wednesday.
- ➤ Garbage Bags **SHOULD NOT EXCEED 50 pounds.**
- Empty carts or cans must be removed from the curbside by 8:00 PM on Thursday.
- If your garbage or recyclables are not collected, contact Spohn's Disposal Service at (315) 866-3665.

ELECTRONICS

- > Residents must deliver electronic waste (i.e. computers, TVs, VCRs, Video Game Consoles) to the Authority's EcoDrop Utica on Leland Ave at no charge or to the Town of Manheim Transfer Station for proper recycling.
- Electronics cannot be placed in your garbage OR in your curbside recycling cart.

TIRES

Residents can deliver them directly to the Authority's EcoDrop Utica on Leland Ave for a fee or contact a private hauler to have them removed.

USED MOTOR OIL

Residents can take used motor oil to a service station, oil redemption center or to the Authority's EcoDrop Utica on Leland Ave at no charge.

PAINTS/CHEMICALS/HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

> Residents may deliver material to the Authority's EcoDrop Utica on Leland Ave from April 1st – September 30th at no charge.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON YOUR RECYCLING CART

Each property that utilizes the Village garbage bags or cart system for garbage will receive one cart for recyclables (at no additional charge).

LOADING YOUR CART

Each cart has easy to follow instructions on what items are accepted for recycling. All recyclable items must be placed inside the cart loosely, with no plastic bags, string, or twine.

Please note: Cardboard boxes should be cut into smaller pieces so that they fit loosely inside the cart. Cardboard <u>will not</u> be accepted if it is placed outside of the recycling cart.

DO NOT PLACE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN YOUR RECYCLING CART:

GARBAGE PLASTIC BAGS STYROFOAM

ELECTRONICS PAINT CANS HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

BATTERIES LIGHT BULBS YARD WASTE

CERAMICS WINDOW GLASS SHARPS (NEEDLES/SYRINGES)

PLACING CART FOR COLLECTION

- Make sure the lid is closed.
- Lid opening must face the street
- Place cart no less than two (2) feet from the curb.
- Carts should be placed at least four (4) feet from obstructions such as garbage bags, garbage carts, mailboxes, parked cars, fire hydrants or utility poles.

<u>Please note:</u> The best placement for recyclables and garbage is on opposite sides of the driveway.
