## ATTENTION RESIDENTS BULKY RIGID PLASTICS ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING

Residents who want to recycle bulky, rigid plastic items that **cannot** be recycled through the curbside recycling program can **deliver them** to the Town of Kirkland Transfer Station **FREE OF CHARGE** on the following days:

MAY 1 THRU OCTOBER 30: **Wednesdays 3:30 PM-5:15 PM and Saturdays 8:00 AM-11:45 AM**

Dates of Exception: July 4 and weekends of Memorial Day & Labor Day)

**WHAT:** Bulky rigid plastics are hard plastic items (not film or flexible plastic).

### EXAMPLES OF BULKY RIGID PLASTICS ACCEPTED

- Plastic beverage crates (i.e., milk/soda/beverage crates)
- Clean plastic drums, totes and empty garbage cans – all sizes
- Clean plastic buckets/pails – all sizes (metal handle acceptable)
- Plastic toys (i.e., playhouses)
- Plastic tool and gun cases
- Plastic plant/propagation trays and flower pots
- Plastic pallets and shelving
- Plastic laundry baskets
- Plastic lawn furniture
- Plastic pet carriers
- Plastic cat litter containers
- Plastic recycling bins & carts
- Large plastic water jugs (1-5 gallon)

**OTHER OPTION:** The Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority will also accept bulky rigid plastics directly from residents who **deliver** them to the EcoDrop Utica. For further information on hours and locations call (315)733-1224 or visit [www.ohswa.org](http://www.ohswa.org).



### BULKY RIGID PLASTICS

**CANNOT** be mixed with other plastic recyclables.

**DO NOT** place bulky rigid plastics with your curbside set-out of recyclables.

### NON-ACCEPTABLE PLASTIC ITEMS:

Plastic bags, plastic film (i.e., stretch film and other flexible packaging), Styrofoam, plastic appliances, vinyl siding, water hoses, toys with circuit boards or battery packs, pool/chemical containers, driveway sealant containers, paint cans and motor oil containers.

# Town of Kirkland 2019 Trash Schedule

**MAY 1 THRU OCTOBER 30**

**Wednesdays 3:30 PM - 5:15 PM**

**Saturdays 8:00 AM - 11:45 AM**

**DATES OF EXCEPTION: JULY 4 & WEEKENDS OF MEMORIAL DAY AND LABOR DAY**

Materials will be accepted from Town of Kirkland residents or construction companies doing work for them only. Sign in is required for each trip, with a limit of five (5) visits per year for wood, trash, construction or roofing materials. Although there will be someone on duty to direct distribution of items into proper containers each date of operation, this is a self-unloading operation. Permission to unload must be given by one of the workers. Charges for construction/roofing materials, wood and trash are listed below. Concrete, hard fill, wood and green material disposal is available but in a separate area. Workers will give directions.

## **ITEMS ACCEPTED**

- Metal: Appliances—Bicycles—Mowers—Pipe, etc.
- Electronics: Computer Hardware, Cell Phones, Printers, Camcorders
- Hard Fill: Wood—Concrete—Glass Windows—Rocks—Bricks & Pallets, etc.
- Mixed/Non-Recyclable: Rugs—Household Fixtures, etc.
- Batteries: Cars—Trucks—Lawn Mowers—Yard Tractors

Cardboard boxes accepted only if transporting mixed non-recyclable items. Your trash hauler must dispose of all other cardboard.

<b>TIRES:</b>	Passenger cars & light trucks without rims	\$2.00 per tire
	Passenger cars & light trucks with rims	\$3.00 per tire
	Truck tires	\$15.00 per tire
	Tractor Tires	\$25.00 per tire
	Large Tractor Tires	\$75.00 per tire

**CONSTRUCTION & ROOFING MATERIALS:** Box larger than 3 yards = \$300

Box 3 yards or smaller = \$150

**WOOD & TRASH:** Quantities larger than 3 yards = \$150

**REFRIGERATORS, AIR CONDITIONERS, ETC.:** A fee of \$20 per item will be charged.

**BAGGED MATERIALS MUST BE IN CLEAR BAGS. GREEN WASTE MATERIAL MUST BE IN BIODEGRADABLE BAGS.**

## **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:**

Paints, Chemicals, Spray Cans, Household Garbage, Recyclables such as cardboard, plastic containers, and glass
