The Town of Trenton Recycling & Solid Waste Collection Center is open to Town of Trenton businesses and residents only.

The Center is staffed during operating hours. Residents are assisted in unloading when possible, but should be aware that they are responsible for unloading their own vehicles.

The Center **DOES NOT** accept by-products of a business unless it was generated from a Town resident. (i.e., The Town will not accept used appliances from an appliance dealer unless the item came from a Town resident). Businesses are required to obtain a signed statement from the resident on a form supplied by the Town. Residents are not allowed to bring material on behalf of non-Town residents or material generated from outside the Town. In order to keep costs down, the Town may require proof of residency. Please do not be offended if you are asked for this information. Many non-Town residents try to use the facility for free. We do not want Trenton taxpayers subsidizing non-resident use.

Attendants often set aside items that may be of use to someone else. These items are on a first come, first take basis. The Town sets aside returnable beverage containers. These may be picked up by Town of Trenton non-profit groups for redemption later. Pick up is on a first come, first take basis.

Acceptable items: Recyclables, appliances, furniture, household items, construction debris and green waste.

Branches that are brought in are run through a chipper and the chips are available free for residents to take home.

The Center **DOES NOT** accept household garbage (i.e., diapers) or hazardous material. Household hazardous waste (i.e., paint, motor oil, pesticides, chemicals) may be taken to the Oneida-Herkimer Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility, Leland Ave. Ext., North Utica [April – September: Monday-Friday 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM and Saturday 8:00 AM – 2:00 PM]. All loads being transported to the Center should be covered to avoid being ticketed by law enforcement.

New Recycling Requirements [over]

- Do NOT use plastic bags for recyclables. **Exception:** Shredded paper may be placed in a clear plastic bag.
- Recyclable containers must be washed clean. Labels do not have to be removed. Do NOT include lids, caps or tops.

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS

★ All Recyclable Items Mix Together In One Bin For Collection ★

1. All recyclable items—paper, plastic, metal, and glass—need to be mixed together loosely in one container.
2. Recyclables must be placed in your designated* recycling bin or a durable plastic or metal lidded container of your choice, under 35 gallons and not more than 50 pounds.
3. Lids and labels should be left on recyclable containers. Containers should be empty and rinsed before recycling.
4. Do not place recyclables in plastic bags for collection. No string, no trash or green waste allowed.

DO NOT INCLUDE:

Metal-Cardboard Containers (Cocoa &
Motor Oil), Clothes Hangers, Silverware
or Small Appliances



GLASS

Green, Amber &
Clear Containers
Canning Jars
Deposit Bottles
Liquor & Wine Bottles
Food & Beverage
Containers

DO NOT INCLUDE:

Broken Glass, Drinking Glasses,
Ovenware or Ceramics, Dishes, Mirrors,
Window Glass or Light Bulbs

★ ONLY ONE EXCEPTION TO THE RULE: SHREDDED PAPER – Place in a clear plastic bag with your recyclables ★

Items That Should Not Be Placed In Your Recycling Bin

- **Sharps**
Do not set out with your recyclables!
Place used needles, syringes and lancets
in a puncture-proof plastic container like
a laundry detergent bottle with a top.
When full, tape lid/top shut, label as
“sharps” and place in the garbage.
- **Garbage**
- **Plastic Bags**
- **Styrofoam**
- **Ceramics**
- **Window Glass**
- **Drinking Glasses**
- **Lawn & Yard Waste**
- **Batteries**
- **Electronics**
- **Household Hazardous Waste**
- **Light Bulbs**
- **Paint Cans**
