Due to ongoing problems with garbage/trash bag sizes "30-gallon" or above, we ask that if your bag size is in question, PLEASE bring the box/container which you purchased the bags in to show the Transfer Site attendant. This should avoid conflicts and possible save you money. Thank you for your cooperation.

- Prices of items not on the list will be based on similar items on the list.
- Steel, metal items, white goods and major appliances are accepted year-round and may be deposited in the dumpster at the Transfer Site.

RECYCLABLES [See NEW Recycling Requirements on Back]

- > No charge for residents of the Village or Town of Boonville. However, if recyclables are **Dirty** there will be a charge.
- > Reminder: Styrofoam and plastic bags are NOT recyclable, therefore, should be disposed of with your garbage/trash.

SPECIAL RECYCLABLE ITEMS: Computers and other electronics may be deposited in a dumpster at the Village of Boonville Transfer Site from April 1st – October 1st. Note: Hard cover books, computers and other electronics may be delivered directly to the Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority facility on Leland Ave. in Utica (Mon. – Fri. 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM and Sat. 7:00 AM – 2:00 PM year-round.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Residents may also bring household hazardous waste such as paint, motor oil and filters, chemicals, pesticides, auto and household batteries, anti-freeze, empty propane tanks under 100 lbs. and fluorescent bulbs to the Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority's Household Hazardous Waste Facility, Leland Ave., Utica from April through September at no charge.

TIRES

> Will Not Be Accepted at the Village of Boonville Transfer Site. Residents can deliver tires for a small fee to the Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority Facility on Leland Ave. in Utica (Mon. – Fri. 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM and Sat. 7:00 AM to 2:00 PM year-round.

YARD WASTE [Grass, Leaves & Twigs] Weekly curbside pick-up by the DPW on Thursdays

- > Yard waste must be loose (NOT containerized or bagged) and left in front of the house for DPW pick-up.
- > Branches/twigs must be no longer than 5' in length.
- Do NOT include plastic pots and garden containers with yard waste; they will not be picked up.

Residents may also bring yard waste to the Village of Boonville Transfer Site. Note: Branches/twigs must be no more than 4" in diameter and no longer than 5' in length.





HERE'S HOW IT WORKS

★ All Recyclable Items Mix Together In One Bin For Collection ★

- 1. All recyclable items—paper, plastic, metal, and glass—need to be mixed together loosely in one container.
- 2. Recyclables must be placed in your designated* recycling bin or a durable plastic or metal lidded container of your choice, under 35 gallons and not more than 50 pounds.
- 3. Lids and labels should be left on recyclable containers. Containers should be empty and rinsed before recycling.
- **4.** Do not place recyclables in plastic bags for collection. No string, no trash or green waste allowed.

DO NOT INCLUDE:

Metal-Cardboard Containers (Cocoa & Motor Oil), Clothes Hangers, Silverware or Small Appliances

Green, Amber & Clear Containers

Canning Jars

Deposit Bottles

Liquor & Wine Bottles

Food & Beverage Containers

DO NOT INCLUDE:

Broken Glass, Drinking Glasses, Ovenware or Ceramics, Dishes, Mirrors, Window Glass or Light Bulbs

 \star ONLY ONE EXCEPTION TO THE RULE: SHREDDED PAPER – Place in a clear plastic bag with your recyclables \star

Items That **Should Not** Be Placed In Your Recycling Bin

Sharps

Do not set out with your recyclables!
Place used needles, syringes and lancets in a puncture-proof plastic container like a laundry detergent bottle with a top.
When full, tape lid/top shut, label as "sharps" and place in the garbage.
