Solid Waste & Recycling Disposal Guidelines - Effective 10/1/2025

Residents have the option to use either Village of Dolgeville garbage bags or carts. The bag and cart system applies to all Village residents and businesses that do not have private dumpster service or a private collection dumpster contract. **Please note: Residents who do not participate in the public solid waste collection system will not receive service for recycling.**

Households that utilize the Village garbage bags or the cart system for garbage will also receive a cart for recyclables. Recyclables must be placed inside the cart loosely, with no plastic bags, string or twine.

Large Quantities/Construction and Demolition Material

- Call a private hauler to rent a dumpster.
- Small pieces of wood, lumber, or construction debris can be placed in a cart or village garbage bags (do not mix with brush or yard waste).
- Construction & demolition debris must be removed by the resident or by arrangement with a private hauler.

Schedule/Rules for Setting Out Garbage and Recyclables

- Garbage and recyclables will be collected on Thursday.
- Garbage should not be out before 3:00pm on Wednesday but should be out before 12:00am on Thursday.
- Garbage bags should not exceed 50 pounds.
- Empty carts or cans must be removed from the curbside by 8:00pm on Thursday.

Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority Drop Off Items

The following items require special disposal and must be brought to the Authority's Utica or Rome EcoDrop or other local recycling programs:

Appliances: Stoves, Refrigerators, Microwaves, Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers, Washers, Dryers

Electronics: TVs, Computers, Monitors, Tablets, Printers, Gaming Consoles, Chargers/Cables

Tires: Vehicle, Lawn Mower, Bicycle, Trailer, Tractor

Batteries: Rechargeable, Tool, Vehicle ***Household Alkaline batteries can go in the garbage.***

Bulk Items: Couches, Recliners, Dressers, Tables, Chairs, Mattresses, Box Springs

Propane Tanks: 1-100lb cylinders, helium tanks

Green Waste: grass, leaves, twigs, branches, Christmas Trees

Bulky Rigid Plastic: laundry baskets, storage totes, 5-gallon buckets, litter boxes, outdoor furniture, toys

Household Hazardous Waste (Utica Only April-September): paint, chemicals, cleaners, pesticides, fertilizers
