Solid Waste/Trash/Recycling/Green Waste Guidelines - Effective 9/1/25

Residents have the option to use either Village of Ilion garbage bags or carts. The bag and cart system applies to all Village residents and businesses that do not have private dumpster service or a private collection dumpster contract. **Please note: Residents who do not participate in the public solid waste collection system will not receive service for recycling, bulk items, electronic waste, steel/metal items, major appliances/white goods, and/or green waste collection.**

Households that utilize the Village garbage bags or the cart system for garbage/trash will also receive a cart for recyclables. Recyclables must be placed inside the cart loosely, with no plastic bags, string or twine. Recyclables placed outside of the cart will not be picked up. Cardboard boxes must be broken down to fit in the cart.

Schedule/Rules for Setting Out Garbage and Recyclables

- Garbage and recyclables will be collected on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.
- Garbage should not be out before 3:00pm but should be out before 12:00am the day before collection.
- Garbage Bags should not exceed 50 pounds.
- Empty carts or cans must be removed from the curbside by 8:00 PM on the collection day.
- If your garbage or recyclables are not collected, please contact Wheelock Disposal Service at (315) 822-3427.

Large Quantities/Construction and Demolition Material (Lumber, Plaster, Wall Board, Plywood)

- For large quantities of materials, arrange dumpster services with a private hauler.
- Small pieces of wood, lumber, or construction debris can be placed in cart or in village bags (Do not mix with yard waste).
- Construction & demolition debris must be removed by the resident, contractor or private hauler.

Bulk Items

- Bulk items are defined as large household items (i.e., couch, chair, mattress, table, rug (rolled & tied), lamp, cabinet, dresser etc.).
- Each property may put out one bulk item on the same day as your garbage pick-up. Multi-units are allowed two bulk items per week.
- Items must not be too large or heavy for two workers to lift.

Electronics, Metal Items, Appliances & White Goods

- These items will be collected on the first and third Friday of each month.
- Items must be called in to Wheelock Disposal Service at (315) 822-3427 to be put on a pick-up list. Please call before the collection day and state what needs to be picked up (i.e., computer, TV, washer, dryer, refrigerator, water heater, etc.) so that special collection arrangements can be made.

Green Waste

- Set out Sunday night for Monday pick-up beginning April 1st – second week of November.
- Green waste must be placed in a reusable container only. Limit of 3 containers per property. All containers must have handles. Containers should not exceed 50 pounds.
- Brush and shrubs cannot exceed 4 feet and must be tied and bundled if they do not fit in a container.
- Christmas trees will be collected at the end of December and during the month of January.

Fall Leaf Collection: The Village of Ilion DPW will continue to pick up leaves in the Fall. Leaves must be placed loose at the curb for collection. Scheduling and preparation for this service will be announced by the Village DPW. (1st Monday in November – as long as weather permits.)

Oneida-Herkimer Solid Waste Authority Drop Off Items

The following items require special disposal and must be brought to the Authority's Utica or Rome EcoDrop or other local recycling programs:

Tires, Batteries, Bulky Rigid Plastic, Propane/Helium Tanks, Motor Oil, Household Hazardous Waste (Utica Only)
